

+ **adjectives** =




There was a **huge, hairy** spider

+ **adjectives** =


A **slimy, sticky** slug was

+ **adjectives** =

I found a **tiny** ladybird
on a **big** leaf.



A butterfly flew into my house.

+ adjectives =


A **blue** and **white** butterfly
flew into my house.



The worm dug through the soil.

+ **adjectives** =

The **wiggly**, **pink** worm
dug through the soil.
