


An adjective is a **describing** word.

There was a **huge**, **hairy** spider in the bathroom. A slug was in my kitchen.

+ adjectives =


A **slimy**, **sticky** slug was in my kitchen.



I found a ladybird on a leaf.

+ adjectives =


I found a **tiny** ladybird on a **big** leaf.



A butterfly flew into my house.

+ adjectives =


A **blue** and **white** butterfly flew into my house.



The worm dug through the soil.

+ adjectives =

The **wiggly**, **pink** worm dug through the soil.
