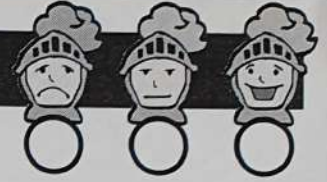


I can use a range of prefixes.

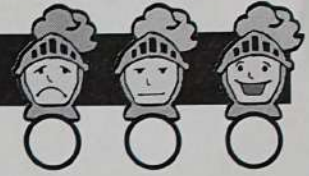
