

Spelling Menu

Choose an activity to practice your spellings with.

Rainbow Write

First, write the words in pencil. Then, trace over them in different colours

Silly Sentences

Write silly sentences using a spelling word in each sentence. Underline the spelling words and write neatly.

Hidden Words

Draw and colour a picture. Hide your spelling words inside the picture. See if someone can find your hidden words

Waterfall Words

Example:

C
Ca
Cat
Cac
Catch

ABC Order

Write your spelling words in alphabetical order. If words start with the same letter, look at the next letter.

Story, Story

Write a story using all of your spelling words. Be sure to underline your spelling words in the paragraph.

Fancy Words

Write your spelling words using fancy handwriting 3 times.

Example:

Catch
Catch
Catch

Three Times

First, write each word in pencil. Then write each word in coloured pencil. Then write each word in felt tip.

Adding my Words

Vowels are worth 10
Consonants are worth 5
Write your words then add the value of each word.
Example:
cat $5+10+5=20$

Riddle Me

Write a riddle for each of your words. Don't forget to answer them.
Example: I am cute, I am fluffy, I like milk. What am I? A cat!

Rhyming Words

Write each of your spelling word with a rhyming word next to them.

Example: Cat – Bat

Code Words

Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet. Then write your words in code.

Example:

A=▽, B=◆, C=Ω

Colourful Words

Write a line of each of your spelling words using a different colour for each letter.

Magazine Words

Use an old magazine or newspaper and find your words or letters that make up words. Glue them down to make each of your spelling words.

UPPER and lower

Write your words one time in uppercase letters and one time in lowercase letters.

Words Within Words

Write each spelling word and then write at least two words made from the letters in that word.

Example:

Catch – cat – hat
