





## Answers to pages 117 - 120

Lady Angelica thinks that Sir Ansell is **stronger** than the Black Knight.

But in many ways he is probably **weaker** than Pip. Sir Ansell thinks that Lady Angelica is the **most** beautiful girl he has ever seen.

He knows for certain that he is the **most handsome** man in the country.

He may be **bigger** and he may be **taller** than Pip, but Pip is definitely **braver** than Sir Ansell.

Sir Ansell might be the **luckiest** knight in the kingdom, but Pip is the **best** squire a knight could have, which is why he decided to squire for the **rudest**, **ugliest**, but **most loyal** knight in the country – the Black Knight!
