

I can tell the difference between a coordinating conjunction and a subordinating conjunction.

A **coordinating conjunction** is used to join two parts of a sentence as an equal pair. ('And', 'but', 'so', 'or' and 'yet' are coordinating conjunctions.)

A **subordinating conjunction** is used to join two parts of a sentence that have an unequal relationship. ('Although', 'until', 'when', 'if', 'while', 'because' and 'before' are subordinating conjunctions.)
