

Monday- Writing the beginning/introduction (Follow the story of the tunnel to help with the structure)





Writing the build-up

Describe the tunnel and build up excitement for the reader!




Wednesday- Writing about the problem (Follow the story of the tunnel to help with the structure)

Next write about the problem your characters face? How do they feel?


Punctuation- use of exclamation mark



Thursday- Writing the resolution (Follow the story of the tunnel to help with the structure)

How do your characters solve the problem? What plan do they make?

How do they both feel? Include adjectives.



Friday- Writing the ending (Follow the story of the tunnel to help with the structure)

The characters go back through the wood, through the tunnel and return home.

Think of an ending. It should not be too short or rushed.

How has their relationship changed?
