For example, The boy is shorter than the man. The man is taller than the boy. Alternatively, A is shorter than B. B is taller than A.




Children will use stem sentences to help them complete the comparisons. Children may struggle visualising objects that need to be stretched out.

Children will create their own sentence comparisons without terminology prompts.




