



Thursday 4th March 2021: World Book Day 'Snuggle up and share a story' Timetable

Class: Year 1 Book: My Book With No Pictures (B.J. Novak)

Here is your suggested timetable for World Book Day which reflects what we will be doing in school. Feel free to join in with these activities or do something of your own!

Morning 1	<p>Share a story – My Book With No Pictures In school Mrs. Trevis will share this story with the class – Please see our website for a video of Mrs. Trevis reading this story to share with your child or alternatively if you have the book read it snuggled up together!</p> <p><u>Become an Illustrator</u> 'My favourite things to do are...' Draw your or paint your favourite things to do! It might be playing football, reading your favourite book, baking, singing, playing games, watching a movie etc. Then, if it's possible to, do it!</p>
Morning 2	<p><u>A Book With No Words</u> 'Next time, please write a book with pictures!' Using mainly pictures, retell your favourite story or create your very own on a story board! (Template on website). Like 'The Book With No Pictures' it doesn't need to make sense! See if you can create some nonsense words to go with your story – e.g. 'pumpsticle!' You could go on a walk to spark your creativity and put two things that you see together to create a new/nonsense word, e.g. bird + worm = borm!</p> <p><u>Try something new!</u> This story definitely put Mrs. Trevis out of her comfort zone by having no choice but to read what you guys had written in the story... Can you do something out of your comfort zone and learn a new skill? It could be baking, sewing, learning how to whistle, learning a new tune on an instrument or a song. You could send in a video of you trying out this new thing!</p>
Afternoon 1	<p><u>Musical</u></p> <p>Use or    </p> <p>book. Remember, anything can be a drum to give you a pretty good drum kit! In maracas and clackers!
