Thursday 4th March 2021: World Book Day 'Snuggle up and share a story' Timetable Class: Year 2 Book: The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Pig

Here is your suggested timetable for World Book Day which reflects what we will be doing in school. Feel free to join in with these activities or do something of your own!

Morning I	Share a story — The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Pig In school Miss Palmer will share this story with the class — Please see our website for a video of Miss Palmer reading this story to share with your child or alternatively if you have the book read it snuggled up together! <u>Twist the Traditional Tale</u> Think of a different traditional tale (Red Riding Hood, The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and The Three Bears or Hansel and Gretel etc). Twist the tale! Can you create your own mini story by swapping the characters round? You could write this or act your new story out using drama skills. Example: The Three Bears investigate the house of Goldilocks. They build a den in the garden, try to fish in the pond and even invade the kitchen for food!
Morning 2	Turn a Traditional Tale into a tasty treat! In class we will create The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Big using biscuits. We will bake and decorate them using icing, marshmallows and chocolate treats. You could also make a mini gingerbread house fit for the witch in Hansel and Gretel. Or bake and decorate your own Gingerbread Man. What could you add to Little Red Riding Hoods basket? Sandwiches, cakes, scones or biscuits? You might even make the perfect porridge that is just right for Goldilocks. You might think of your own idea. Enjoy!
Afternoon I	Outdoor Adventures At the end of the story The Three Little Wolves decide to build their house from flowers. In class we are going to build houses using only nature. Grab an explorer's bag or create your own. You could go on a walk or search your garden and collect interesting natural materials to build a house. What will you use to make each part? Be creative with your ideas and have lots of fun!
Afternoon 2	World Book Day Assembly with Miss Martin. Please see our website for a link for this assembly <u>Crazy Character Crafts-</u> In class the children are going to pick and make their favourite traditional tale character. You could use a wooden spoon, kitchen roll, paper plates or egg cartons. Please see the craft ideas sheet. <u>Traditional Tale Treasure Hunt</u> Can you solve the riddles and match them to the traditional tale cards. How fast can you do it? Please see the riddles sheet.
