Morning 1	<p>Who was The Hobbit?</p> <p>Discover the wide variety of characters and settings included in the Hobbit, or share your knowledge of Middle-Earth with your friends. You never know, we may even be blessed with a special guest!</p>
Morning 2	<p>Enter the world of Middle-Earth</p> <p>The class will read some of the most iconic pages from the Hobbit, there will be action, suspense and of course opportunity for children to perform as some of the legendary heroes (and villains) from the pages.</p>
Afternoon 1	<p>Riddles in Dark</p> <p>Deep in the bowels of Moria, Golem attempts to outwit Biblo with his riddles. Can you figure out his riddles and are you able to craft your own to seize the power of the One Ring for yourself?</p>
Afternoon 2	<p>A tale of dragons</p> <p>Learn how to draw Smaug, the last great dragon of Middle-Earth.</p> <p>Practise drawing a huge dragon's eye, like the one Bilbo is faced with once the great drake wakes from his slumber.</p>
