### **Apostrophes for Missing Letters**




Use an apostrophe to show where you've left letters out of a shortened word.



### **Apostrophes for Single Possession**



To show that someone or something owns something, add an apostrophe and 's'.

For singular nouns, you always add the 's', even if the word ends in 's' already.

apostrophe + 's' the cook's pot the walrus's tusks apostrophe + 's'




