Brackets for Extra Information

Brackets are used to separate extra information from the rest of a sentence. You always need a pair of brackets — never use one on its own.

Uncle Nigel (my dad's older brother) works on a farm.

The bit inside the brackets is the extra information.

The rest of the sentence would still make sense without it.
