Punctuating Speech



Speech always ends with a punctuation mark, which goes inside the speech marks.

If speech starts part-way through the sentence, you need to add a comman before the speech.

Mia said, "Is he alright?"

Speech always starts with a capital letter, even when it isn't at the start of the sentence.


