The team meet once a fortnite, working together to provide the necessary support that vulnerable learners may need in school.

Vulnerable Learners at Hutton Rudby Primary School could be any child, either for a one off point, a particular period or their entire time at school. Pupils in the following categories will always be considered vulnerable learners

- Looked After Children
- Pupils on the SEND register
- Pupils with specific medical needs
- Pupils with individual care plans
- Pupils who have come from a split family
- Pupil Premium Children – those Ever 6 children in receipt of free school meals
- Children who have emotional/behavioural difficulties, including historical trauma or mental health issues
- Pupils at risk of underachieving in core subjects identified at pupil progress meetings
- Pupils with poor attendance below 85%
